• The application is made at Migración Colombia. • During the induction week, mobility advisors will guide you through this process. 3. Entry Permit/Stamp (for short programmes)

• If your nationality allows you to enter without a visa, the initial permit is valid for 90 days. • You must renew it online on the Migración Colombia website before it expires.

• It is mandatory for extended stays and serves as an identity document.

• If you enter with a student visa, you must apply for one within the first 15 days after your arrival.

- Keep in mind! • If you are pursuing a double degree or spending an exchange year at Icesi University, you must obtain a student visa.
 - After your arrival, you must send a photo of your entry permit or stamp to the mobility advisors at: mobility@icesi.edu.co


